I just wanted to pass along our appreciation of the efforts of Scott York and Erik Weiss during the past year. Scott has been the lead electrician on four long-term projects for FCE during 2007 and 2008, and 3 of these projects were tests of new product lines that have been successfully rolled out. They are among of the largest fuel cell plants in the world and are considered the largest single commercial fuel cells in their respective areas:

Canada (1.2MW in Toronto)
